


In 1949 the National Reactor Testing Station was established in the Idaho desert to prove that nuclear energy could be harnessed for peaceful civilian use. Over the next quarter century 52 reactors were demonstrated on what is now the Idaho National Laboratory site, laying the foundation for the commercial nuclear industry that today provides the majority of the nation's clean energy.
