SCOPE OF NUCLEAR TECHNOLOGY/FUSION (NT/F)

NT/F contains technical papers dealing with applied research related to the development of fusion power. This includes such topics as plasma engineering, fusion blankets, materials development, magnet technology, tritium handling, mechanical aspects, inertial confinement fusion driver technology, and system concepts and evaluations.

The following questions should be considered as a basis for the preparation of your comments and recommendations. Any additional comments you may wish to make will be greatly appreciated. *If possible, have your comments typewritten with an unsigned copy appropriate for transmittal to the author.*

1. Is this an original contribution?
2. Does it give adequate credit to earlier work in the field?
3. Is it correct and complete? List technical errors or unjustified conclusions:
 - a. clearly wrong
 - b. may be wrong
 - c. must be answered.

4. Is it clearly presented?
5. Is the abstract adequate, emphasizing any results clearly for use in abstracting journals?
6. Will it be of interest to the readers of the journal who are drawn from ANS/ENS membership?
7. Should it be published?
 - a. as is
 - b. with minor revision
 - c. with major revision
 - d. complete rewrite.

Note: Copy editors will correct typographical, spelling, and minor grammatical errors. Do not feel obliged to find such errors and do not correct style. If the writing is unacceptable or it can be improved, so state, but do not rewrite for the author.

It is only necessary to return the manuscript with your comments if corrections or changes have been indicated in it that should be called to the author's attention.
