Serious production problems have forced us to switch from a computer-driven Photon typesetter to an IBM typewriter. This process and the composition house using it (Beljan, Ann Arbor, Michigan) are the same as used for *Nuclear Science and Engineering*. In switching, we expect to improve the accuracy and appearance of the journal and to enable the reader to receive each copy early in the month of issue.

We feel that eventually computer-set type will be widely used, even for scientific material, and that we have gained experience which will be valuable at that time. However, we also feel that the necessity of producing a satisfactory product at this time demands such a change.
